The Sudbury Council supports a number of needs in the Church, Community, Family and Youth areas, such as:

In the Catholic Church

Our members are involved in Church Ministries such as: Pastoral Visitors, ushers, lectors, Eucharistic Ministers and Altar Servers. We contribute financial aid to individual Seminarians and Postulants. We bestow yearly Altar Server Awards. At Christmas time, we post "Keep Christ in Christmas" posters in several local parishes.

In the Community

Our members are involved in Town Volunteer Activities such as: Meals on Wheels, FISH, Food Pantry, and Bridges Program. We sponsor fund raising events for special causes, such as for the needs of a severely injured person. One such event succeeded in raising \$92,000 for the recipient.

In our Families

We host Church Hospitality functions, picnics for inner city children, social events such as St. Patrick Day and Oktoberfest dinner/dances. We visit the sick of the Council Family and bring Communion to those who are homebound.

With our Youth

We sponsor a Free Throw Basketball Contest and an inter parish Softball Tournament. In the Summer we sponsor a day's outing for children from Holy Family Day Camp of **Dorchester, MA.**

With Special Needs Children and Adults

Through our yearly "Tootsie Roll Drive" we raise money to help fund equipment for mentally challenged children and adults, and for physically handicapped children.

The Knights of Columbus began in the basement of St. Mary's Church in New Haven Conn. in 1882, when Father Michael J. McGivney* called together a small group of pioneering Catholic laymen and founded a society designed to provide financial assistance for the widows and orphans of its members. Father McGivney's original idea grew quickly into an organization of Catholic men and their families dedicated to promoting the concepts of Faith, Family and Fraternity.

Today, there are over 1.7 million members in 13 countries in 12,000 local units called councils.
